Pick up your Bible-everyone in the congregation is encouraged to read ACTS during Lent. A calendar will be mailed to you to help you do this-reading just a portion each day for 40 days. Acts is known as THE LINKING BOOK: it gives a transition from the life of Christ to the new church. Acts resumes the story of Jesus, hinting that history will show Jesus at work, but in a quite different form. "I will build my church" Jesus promised. Acts graphically shows how that process began.
