Questions & Answers About the 2023 Shine Your Light Gala

Questions & Answers About the 2023 Shine Your Light Gala as this is our first ever Gala, our committee is working hard to make it as successful as possible. Of course, with every first event, there are a lot of questions about how everything will work and what to expect. Let us *Shine some Light* on a few questions we have heard recently.

What is the main purpose of the Gala?

The initial thought for the Gala was born during a Stewardship meeting as we brainstormed ways to create more involvement, build community, provide fun experiences and increase giving in the church. As the plan evolved, we settled on using this opportunity to raise money to help pay down the principal on our mortgage.

Why are we partnering with the M3 Foundation?

- Partnering with the M3 Foundation creates a connection that can benefit both of us. We are bringing a bigger light to their purpose: increasing awareness for and decreasing the stigma of mental health and suicide prevention. They are shining a light on our church as a partner in their mission! This Gala will bring guests from their foundation into our church.
- When Pastor Randy was here, he completed a survey with our congregation. From all the data collected, Pr. Randy summarized seven points of guiding principles for our church. Three of these were: 1) A focus on Evangelism and Outreach; 2) Service to the neighborhood and community outside the walls of the church; and 3) A focus on the vision and mission points of the church. It is time we act on those goals, and this is one way to get started.
- The top priorities for CtK's vision and mission were also identified in that survey. The top 2 were middle school youth and high school youth. These are two populations that are the most at risk for mental health and suicide right now. These are our youth, children of our neighborhood and community.
- This Gala provides the perfect opportunity for our church to increase our evangelism, outreach and service to our neighborhood and community! By partnering with M3, we are supporting a local foundation that directly impacts and supports our youth and community, as well as everyone else who struggles with mental health.
- Megan MacFarlane, the Executive Director of M3, is a child of Christ the King. She was raised here, confirmed here, and graduated from here. She has one of our precious quilts. This makes our first partnership for our first gala even more meaningful.

What percentage of monies raised will stay at CtK and what will go to M3?

- 80% of monies raised will stay at Christ the King and go directly toward paying down the principal of the mortgage.
- 20% of monies raised will be given to the M3 Foundation for their continued ability to provide support to our community for those struggling with and affected by mental health.

What is the dress code?

Semi-formal <u>optional</u>. Dress up if you love an opportunity to do so or come as you are! All are welcome!

CtK Youth Fundraiser

We have a unique fundraiser called "144 Envelopes" happening again for CtK Youth, for our summer trip to St. Louis MO, June 24-30

They are numbered 1-144 and people can select a numbered envelope from the wall, bring it to the office and donate that corresponding amount. Thank you so much to the generous folks who have already claimed their envelopes and donated that amount!

For example, if you pull the #2 envelope off the wall, you would donate \$2.00 to CtK Youth; if you choose the #15 envelope, you'd donate \$15.00, or a #125 numbered envelope would be a \$125.00 gift and so on with the corresponding amount. This fundraising campaign allows for individuals to donate small and large amounts.

Last year we made \$1,800, which was absolutely amazing! Thank you for all your support

If our supporters select all 144 envelopes, then we raise more than TEN THOUSAND DOLLARS! Yay!

From the Pastor

I'm Home! As I have said to so many when I have connected with them over the last couple of weeks, this call just seems right! Right for me and I think right for the Lutheran Church of Christ the King. It was always my dream and hope that I would some day return to CTK – I just never dreamed it would be as soon as it was but I am thankful that everything fell into place as it did.

Let me catch you all up. Since I left CtK a little over 7 years ago, I continued to finish out my Masters Degree at Luther Seminary while I also continued to work at M State full-time in the Registrar's Office. When it came time to find an internship location for my degree the Bishop placed me into two rural churches – the Perley Parish in Perley, MN and Gardner, ND. It was a wonderful 4 ½ years with the members of those congregations.
