Call Committee Update

Tuesday 1/24/2023 the Call Committee officially recommended a candidate to the Church Council. From here, there is still a significant amount of work to be done before the congregation will hold the final vote as to whether they are willing to call this person.

- Step 1: Call committee recommends candidate to council (Done!)
- Step 2: Council decides whether they are willing to move forward with the candidate.
- Step 3: Council negotiates pay / benefits with the candidate.
- Step 4: Background checks are completed. Step 5: Synod + Bishop signs off on final compensation agreements.
- Step 6: Council chooses a time + date for the congregation to hold a vote.
- Step 7: Congregation votes on whether to call this individual.

We anticipate that it will take, at minimum, two months to complete this process. Of course, this is if we don't hit any snags along the way.

Thank you all for your continued patience, prayers and support as we move through this process.



February 2023 Newsletter

I recently reread a book my mother encouraged me to read years ago. It was written by a relative of mine. In fact, he is the pastor who baptized me. I was interested to read this autobiography of one who had served the church and who also had the opportunity to do a lot of traveling. Admittedly, I began to read hoping to catch some glimpses of countries and people I could only dream of meeting. However, one of the highlights of the book for me was a story he told about a particular youth meeting he attended. The question which opened the discussion was, "If I moved to a new community, what kind of church would I join?" This is a good question which would be good for each of us to ask ourselves. What would we look for in a new congregation? He told of some of the predictable responses like, "I would join a church with plenty of choir members so I wouldn't have to go to choir practice." "I would join a church that had plenty of money so I wouldn't have to give so much." "I would join a church that had plenty of Sunday School teachers, so I wouldn't have to stay home on Saturday nights to prepare a lesson while others were out having a good time." The last person in the circle offered a startling and yet thought-provoking

"I would join the church where they were always short of Sunday School teachers so I could teach and share the Good News with others. I would join the church where they always needed money so I could share my tithe with that church. I would join the church that was short of choir members so I could use my tenor voice to help sing God's praises. I would join the church where the pastor was not quite so capable as others, and I would go to him and ask what I could do to help him in his ministry."

All too often, we're inclined to identify with the first group of responses. We seek the path of least resistance – even when it comes to matters of faith. The first group of responses don't seem to indicate a *joyous* response to being part of God's family. One senses a desire to escape as much responsibility as possible.

The last person's response all but bubbles over with the desire to share the gifts God had entrusted to them! This person sought out the challenges which others avoided all because they provided an opportunity to share in the ministry of Christ's church. It's a matter of stewardship – caring for and sharing that which God has given us!

I realize this isn't "stewardship time". That is, this isn't the traditional time of the year when we're accustomed to talking about stewardship. However, as I always taught in confirmation, stewardship is *NOT* to be limited to a couple of weeks or a month of each year. Rather, it *needs* to be a part of our everyday lives!!

I would like to suggest you begin each day by asking yourself first, "What does Christ want to accomplish through our congregation?" Secondly, and equally important, we need to ask ourselves, "What gifts do I have to offer to help our congregation in this ministry?" It's a challenge to *LIVE* our faith! Yet, if we claim the name of Christ, we discover God will continually strengthen and equip us for our ministry!!

May God bless you as together we serve Christ!!
