As I write by July perspective, I am preparing to head out for VBS later in the week and off to St. Louis for the Youth Mission Trip on Sunday. Lots of fun and amazing things lay ahead for the youth of CTK.

We are beginning to fill in the missing pieces in our staff here and I look forward to this new team. Change is never easy and I pray that you will all allow us a bit of grace as we navigate the ins and outs of what we've always done before, what we plan on doing now and what we might have in mind for the future.

As of now the latest news is this:

- 1. We have filled our Office Administrator position with our own CTK member Jo Marie Fike. She will be pairing this position with her half-time Director of Worship to be the constant in planning both the traditional, contemporary and all that goes with the music here at the church. I am thrilled to see Jo Marie coming back full-time at CTK and look forward to her innovative and creative ideas in the service planning process.

- 4. Finally, you are aware that Isaac will be leaving us at the end of July. He has been such a gift to CTK through all of the pandemic years and we know that his talent and kind spirit will be a blessing at some new college/university before you know it. With his position being eliminated and Jo Marie's position changing it was felt that we no longer needed Scott Avans and the two musicians he hired, Miriam and Krista for the Contemporary side. Scott completed his time with us on Friday, June 9th and was excited for what CTK is moving forward in regarding Contemporary Worship. It is my hope that we see him back here at some point singing or playing with us.

It is going to take all of us to work through these changes and adjustments. What I do know is that we have great new opportunities awaiting us here at CtK and I can't wait to *"Build Church Together"* with all of you!
