It's August already and I still have so much I want to get done, are you feeling a bit that way as well???

I am thrilled that I am taking a few days off next week but am also panicking as Rally Sunday and the kick-off to our Church season getting going again is fast approaching. We have some exciting new things going on at CtK this fall and I can't wait to see the church full of excited and God-filled people again. In these final prep weeks we will be giving some spaces face lifts as we move the children's and youth spaces around a bit to accommodate our new partners in our space. With that, it has given us an opportunity to update and utilize some spaces that we weren't using to their full potential and make them a bit more welcoming and useful.

We have a beautiful and spacious building and while some of our normal activities may now be taking place in different locations than in the past, we have much more room than we could ever need so don't ever worry about your event not having room. Please come see me if you have any concerns so we can work on solutions for those worries together.

Along with new spaces we are revamping our children's ministry grouping a bit as well and will be breaking the children into three groups this year. The Lesson for the night will be introduced to all children during the Children's message during the service and the kids will then head off to their perspective spaces to continue the lesson. All three groups will be working on the same lesson each week – just at the level of learning that is appropriate for them. This will allow you as a family to be able to have a conversation in the car on the way home with all of them asking "what did you learn about tonight?" I am looking forward to giving this opportunity to families to continue the conversations outside of the church walls after Wednesday night is over.

Finally, based on the number of children and youth that we currently have at CtK we cannot justify a Full-Time position to cover this area. We will continue to keep Steph on Staff at her current 10 hrs/week coordinating the Children's Ministry lessons and teachers. I will continue to work on finding someone to help – at least help me – create and schedule youth events twice a month. I know it is definitely not ideal but it will be how we will at least start the fall and hopefully our numbers will grow and we can look at things differently for 2025. If you or you know of someone interested in helping me out with the youth please let me know.

Enjoy the last few weeks of the summer!!!!! Keep an eye out on the website and Facebook pages middle of August as we post the pictures of our new updated spaces.

HVAC UPDATE

As of July 31, we have collected \$151,200 towards our goal to purchase the new HVAC units! Greetings CtK Members and Friends -

Last spring Christ the King was approached about housing the Odyssey FM Action Academy, a K-12th grade Charter school on our premises. Mike and Emily Koska, the people working to establish the school, were looking for space in Moorhead.

Council unanimously approved pursuing this opportunity and after multiple meetings and emails between the Koska's and CtK, we were able to determine that we could meet their space needs while still being able to serve our Christ the King family's needs. Originally the Rainbow Room area had been designed just for this purpose – for being a home for a school or daycare.

A lease for the upcoming school year was signed in July providing us with an additional revenue stream. We were required to obtain insurance coverage to have a school on site, coverage our current carrier was unable to provide. While our new insurance policy premium will be higher, due to this addition, we will still be provided with a small amount of other revenue that can help us to meet our current maintenance needs. If you will recall, we have, for multiple years past, projected budgeted losses based on our pledged general income dollars received during our stewardship drives each fall.

This is an amazing opportunity to fully utilize our building space, while also provide a source of income and invite our community into our beautiful church. It will be different, having a school, kids and teachers present during the week, but we are hopeful we can learn to be together. Please keep this new school; Ctk staff and your Council in your prayers as we navigate this new beginning at CtK!
